What is TMEC?

The Teen Marijuana Education Course (TMEC) was developed by Certified Prevention Specialists in partnership with law enforcement, schools, treatment, and medical professionals in Oregon. TMEC was launched in 2017 to teach youth and adults ages 13 and above the facts about marijuana.

What's new?

The curriculum has been revised and CLEAR Alliance is releasing the **new 2019 TMEC revision**.

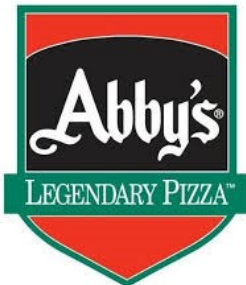
